Nutsedge will emerge in the turf and landscape areas in late June through July. Wet soils will contribute to an increase population. This plant quite often comes in with new topsoil stripped from low lying areas.

Nutsedge:

Perennial , grass-like plant.
Glossy, light green narrow leaves in groups of three.
Reproduces by tubers (nuts) and rhizomes.
Emerges in late June to July. Nutsedge
Mow today, back up again tomorrow.
Standard weed control products will not control nutsedge.
Best time for control is July through Sept. with the product (Sedgehammer).
Application is a liquid and needs to be timed to avoid mowing within a few days.

This is a difficult weed. It is best to treat two consecutive years for best results. One application does produce good results, and may last for several years. This usually can be accomplished with spot treat applications.

The minimum charge is \$50 to spot treat.

The maximum cost of 1.5 times your spring/crab fertilization rate to treat your entire lawn.
